Lawndale School Readiness Program

When 18 month-old Xander showed signs of delayed speech and motor skills his father, Nestor Henriquez, wasn't sure how to help his child. But, thanks to the Parent Educator who visited his home monthly to implement the Parents As Teachers (PAT) program, he learned how to work with his toddler. Henriquez quickly learned how to use everyday activities, singing, reading, exercises, and crafts projects to advance Xander's development.

"He was only speaking a few words and we could tell he wasn't hearing properly" said Henriquez, a stay-at-home dad. After two ear operations, weekly visits from a speech therapist and daily coaching from Dad, Xander now speaks in sentences and is participating in preschool.

Henriquez says he has learned as much as his son during the two years both have been involved in the Lawndale School Readiness Program – a collaboration between the Lawndale Elementary School District and the Richstone Family

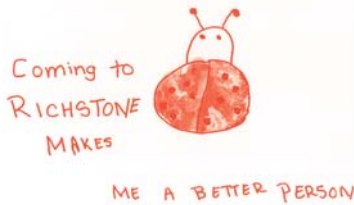
Center – which is funded by First 5 LA.

Emerging as a parent leader, Henriquez has gone on to inspire other fathers in his neighborhood to become more involved in their children's early learning. He has helped other dads get involved, and speaks regularly to parents about the importance of being intimately involved in children's development from infancy.

The home visitation program serves 200 families annually, providing one-on-one coaching to increase knowledge of childhood development, parenting skills, early detection of developmental delays and health issues as well as school readiness.



Center for Positive Parenting



Since 1994, Richstone's Center for Positive Parenting has provided parenting classes for hundreds of parents every year. Inspired by the desire to support and strengthen families through parent education, the Center provides classes located throughout the cities of Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach and Manhattan Beach. The class offerings are varied and designed to meet the challenges faced by many parents. Open to all parents, offerings include classes that focus on parenting infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and school-age children. We also provide a class for single parents.

This year, a new class series - "Middle School to High School Transition: How Parents Can Help" is being offered. This new program was developed in partnership with the Beach Cities Health District, which, along with Richstone, has funded this project since its inception. The class responds to identified community needs to assist parents to prepare their children to make a successful transition from middle school to high school. Special emphasis is placed on the social/emotional aspects of this transition to help reduce the increasing numbers of 9th graders involved in the use of alcohol.

One Father's Story....

A young, divorced father of a 4-year-old daughter enrolled in the 6 week Preschool Series. He had previously taken a parenting class at another agency as a court requirement to attain partial custody of his child. He felt that the class was not entirely relevant and had not met his needs.

During the time he attended the Center's Preschool series, he commented that not only had the classes helped him improve his interaction with his daughter when he saw her, but they also alleviated much of the tension that existed between him and his ex-wife. He realized that his communication skills with his child and her mother were mostly negative and created an unhealthy environment for everyone. He also admitted that because of his self-imposed heavy work schedule, he really did not spend as much family time as he would have liked. But now he was making positive changes to improve his relationship with his daughter. He commented at one meeting that he wished he had all this information earlier in his marriage – that perhaps his relationships would be different.

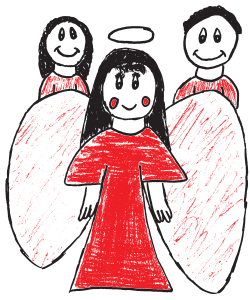
He has since attended several one-session workshops, hoping to "fine tune" his parenting, so that he can provide a more positive life for his daughter as she grows.
